Based on ICHD-3 guidelines, to be diagnosed with migraine, a person needs to have **at least five attacks** that fulfil these criteria:²

Headache duration²



Lasts **4–72 hours**

Headache characteristics²

At least two of the following:



Unilateral



Pulsating



Moderate-to-severe
pain intensity



Aggravated by routine
physical activity

Non-headache symptoms²

At least one of the following:



Sensitivity to
light and sound



Nausea and/or **vomiting**
